

Ultimate Safaris establishes computer laboratory at Khorixas school

As part of their strategy to support grassroots education and build a foundation for a sustainable tourism workforce, Ultimate Safaris, through their Conservation Travel Foundation, sponsored a new computer laboratory, consisting of 8 computers, at the Th. F. !Gaeb Primary School in Khorixas.

The computer laboratory at the Th. This is the same school from which two learners were previously awarded Ultimate Safaris scholarships to attend private high school education at Windhoek Gymnasium High School.
